

**All-Terrain Vehicle/ Utility Terrain Vehicle
AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING
A section of County Highway EE as an ATV/UTV Route**

Section I – Intent: The Town of Draper of the County of Sawyer adopts the following all-terrain vehicle ordinance/route for the operation of all-terrain / utility terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this ordinance has been created.

Section II - Statutory Authority: This route is created pursuant to town authority, with concurrence of the Sawyer County Board of Supervisors, under Wisconsin Statutes as authorized by 23.33 (8) (b), Wis. Stats.

Section III – Route: The following road segment is designated as a route and added to the list of roads previously designated as routes by action of the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Draper;

A. County Highway EE from U.S. Forest Road 161 east to the Price County/Sawyer County Line

B. Said route is further described and identified by the attached map.

Section IV – Conditions: As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers where applicable);

A. ATV/ UTV’s shall be operated on the paved surface of County Highway EE and

B. The speed limit for ATV/UTV operation on this route shall be posted at 35 mph

C. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7) c. ATV Route Guideline and Suggestions (A Community Official's Handbook)

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Section V – Enforcement: This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer of the Sawyer County Sheriff’s Department and the Wisconsin DNR County, Wisconsin.

Section VI – Penalties: Wisconsin state All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33 (13) (a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section VII – Severability: The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Draper Board of Supervisors would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other person’s circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

Section VIII - Effective Date: This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
